

4 Bolt Fans - Bill Hughes

I started making these about 10 years ago. As you are probably well aware the bedbar ajustment bolts on the four point Toro greens reels and the 5000 series fairway reels along with many of the Jac reels have adjustment bolts with the 3/8" square heads. They often round off with very little pressure.

This wrench has two small (I use 7/16" or 1/2") 3/8" drive sockets cut in half and the square ends are welded to a short (6") piece of flat steel so that one of the ends is square with the steel and the other rotated 45 degrees. This allows one side of the wrench or the other to easily slip on the bolt no matter which way the bolt is turned. Much easier to deal with than the 3/8" wrench and it does not slip off and get the knuckles banged.
