Just done building one here

Cost for steel was \$700 and primer, paint, etc was \$80. I made it 10ft wide to give them more than a few inches to back the topdresser under. Only thing was I have a sheet and a half left over off of the list of metal so would have been \$150 cheaper. That's ok though because it's always nice to have around and super had ideas of more things for me to build. I love to fabricate things and have done a lot of other projects over many years but I always forget to take pictures of them.
