

## **Smallest Spray Boom??**

Probably the least expensive spray boom you can find. The problem was the time it took to spray large bunkers, sometimes called "waste" areas with a 25 gallon tank and spray wand. The Assistant Super at the Vinoy in St. Petersburg, FL came up with this idea. Take 3/4 PVC and build a boom frame. Attach regular "Tee Jet" fan nozzles as you would on a normal boom. Put air line quick disconnects on the tank hose, the spray wand, and the boom. The spray boom is held on with 1 bungee cord. To use it you simply unplug the wand, plug in the boom.
